1. What is Disciple Now?

HOST HOME INFO



“Host Homes” are families at FBC Meridian that have agreed to open up their home for the weekend of Disciple Now. Here is some information for host homes:

- host home families are primarily responsible for simply opening up their home
- host home families are invited to attend everything that goes on at DNOW weekend but are not obligated to attend anything
- host home families are only required to supply breakfast for the students on Saturday morning. FBC will provide dinner Friday night, lunch Saturday afternoon and breakfast Sunday morning. A group of parents will provide dinner on Saturday night.
- host home families are responsible for informing the students and leaders of household rules that NEED to be followed. The leaders can work with the host home family in enforcing the rules.
- host home families are not required to lead any Bible studies or small groups but can participate during these times if the small group leader is ok with this.

LEADER INFO



A leader at Disciple Now is typically a college student or a young single who leads a small group and builds relationships with students. These leaders typically come from outside of our church to provide a fresh perspective for our students. With that, here are several things in regards to being a leader:

- leaders are primarily responsible for leading small group discussions, keeping the students (somewhat) in line, and building relationships with the students.
- leaders need to come to Disciple Now having already prepared for their small group sessions. We wholeheartedly believe that the more you prepare the more effective you will be.
- we will get the sermon topics along with discussion questions to you two weeks before the weekend.
- you have a great deal of flexibility with the sessions! Feel free to use your own creative ingenuity to map out your small group sessions. We are committed to providing you sermon outlines for each of the two talks and discussion questions for every small group session but you can step outside of this and do additional things as well!
