

That means we are almost ready to endeavor upon our F260 Bible Reading Plan together. I challenge you to make the journey with us. We will be providing printed copies of the reading plan on our information table, posting weekly readings on social media and through our weekly publications, and putting the reading plan on our website. Additionally, John Temple has prepared sample questions for reflection on all 260 readings and a weekly devotion to go with each group of readings. These can be used as an aide for you in your reading or in discussion with your class and/or family. We will be copying and binding his questions and devotions to make them available some time in December.

By way of reminder, we encourage you to reflect on your daily Bible readings by working through the questions of the 7 Arrows method:

- 1. What does the passage mean/say (summarize)?
- 2. What did the passage mean to its original audience (remember, we will provide brief postings on a daily basis through Facebook and through the church website to assist with this)?
- 3. What does the passage teach us about God?
- 4. What does the passage teach us about mankind?
- 5. What does this passage demand of me?
- 6. How does this passage change the way I relate to people?
- 7. How does this passage prompt me to pray?

To assist you, we will be providing free 7 Arrows bookmarks on our information table in the church foyer. They will also be available in December. We will also have a daily posting on our church Facebook called "The Second Arrow" to provide some background context on the day's Bible reading.

Remember, God has breathed life into His Word and into His people because He intended the two for a close relationship with each other. Brothers and sisters, let's get in God's Word together. Parents and Grandparents, let's raise the next generation with the unchanging Word of God in the midst of an ever-changing world. I can't wait to start.
