# Church Family,

The season of Advent is a time of anticipation and—for many anxiety. Each of the four Sundays of Advent reminds us of

the focal truths of this Season that give us perspective on our lives in light of the salvation heralded by our Savior's birth. This Sunday, the second Sunday of Advent, we light the "Peace" candle. The peace candle always reminds me of a famous quote from Augustine's Confessions: "You have made us for Yourself, and our hearts are restless until they can find rest in you." Peace (shalom in Hebrew, eirene in Greek) is not ultimately understood as the absence of conflict or adversity, but as the presence of right, life-giving relationship.

True peace can only be found in the One who creates life and—through the sacrifice of Jesus—redeems it. So many of our anxieties highlight all of the things other than God that we pursue as the source of our peace. How appropriate that Jesus is prophesied as the "Prince of Peace" (Isaiah 9:6), and that His earliest followers speak of having a "peace that surpasses all understanding" (Philippians 4:7)! Believing in Jesus may not make all of your situations understandable, but it can provide a peace beyond your understanding.

As we light the Peace candle this Sunday, may we be reminded that despite all that is wrong in the world, Jesus has made us right with God. That's more than *something*; ultimately, it will be everything. Peace to you until we meet again.
