"CLOTHED"

A New Sermon Series

on **Sin and Salvation** beginning March 8 10:30 a.m.

Church Family,

Last week, I asked my mom to dig up an old yearbook picture of me from the fourth grade. It was as bad as I remembered (*Don't worry, you'll get to see it for yourself in an upcoming sermon*). The first thing I noticed were my *clothes*—I remember thinking, "I CAN'T BELIEVE I WORE *THAT!*" Spoiler alert: I was wearing a purple turtleneck. If there's anything I learned from fourth grade picture day, it's that clothes matter.

With rare and awkward exceptions, clothing is an everyday reality for the vast majority of the world's population. Globally, the retail clothing market is worth almost 1.5 *TRILLION* DOLLARS! Footwear alone is worth \$366 BILLION. Clothing is far from *purely* functional. Athletes and celebrities receive millions of dollars to endorse certain clothes or clothing brands. Social media "influencers" receive advertising revenue for taking would-be candid (but, in reality, carefully staged) pictures wearing select brands so that their "followers" will flood stores to obtain the latest fashionable apparel.

Our clothing demonstrates how we *want* to be seen and affects how we are seen by others, especially in a culture in which "perception is reality." Even on the professional front, we are told, "*Dress* for the job you want, not the job you have." So, to claim that "clothes matter" is actually putting it rather mildly. Interestingly, the Bible has a lot to say about clothing, going all the way *back* to the garden of Eden (see Genesis 3) and looking all the way forward to the return of Christ (see 1 Corinthians 15 and Revelation 22:14, for example). This Sunday, we will begin a ten-week sermon series, "CLOTHED," which explores the overarching story of the Bible by giving a closer look at clothing. Spoiler alert: clothes matter.
