

THE PROPHETS

- Communicate the message embodied by the OT story.
 - Israel repeats Adam on a national scale
 - As Adam was sent from Eden, Israel goes into Exile.
 - God has a redemptive plan beyond the failures of his people.

The Structure of Isaiah

1-39	40-55	56-66
Assyria	Babylon	Persia
Pre-exile	Exile	Post-Exile
Judgment	Comfort/Hope	Restoration

THE STRUCTURE OF JEREMIAH

- Jeremiah's CALL
 - Judgment against JUDAH
 - Consolation & New Covenant
 - Judgment against NATIONS
- Jerusalem's COLLAPSE

JEREMIAH has a CHIASTIC structure rather than a LINEAR structure. The heart of the message is at the center of the book (this is also the case for Jeremiah's other book, Lamentations).



 - Vision, Voice, and Hand (Creation?)
- Opening Vision: Moving Throne
- Two Part Message (Judgment & Hope)
- Key Teaching: Resurrection/Restoration
