

At the annual meeting of the Southern Baptist Convention in Nashville, TN earlier this summer, a friend of mine—Pastor John Blackmon of

Meansville Baptist Church (GA)—made a motion during one of the business meeting sessions to raise the priority of ministries to the deaf community. At first glance, this may seem like an odd request—only four percent of Christians are deaf, so most churches don't have a deaf ministry. But how we frame the numbers matters. Globally, there are somewhere between 250 and 300 million deaf people. While only four percent of Christians are deaf, ONLY TWO PERCENT of deaf people are Christians. That means ninety-eight percent of a 250-to-300 million population group do not have the hope of heaven at present because they do not know Jesus as Savior and Lord.

What can we do about this? I, for one, only know a handful of symbols from the American Sign Language system. The good news is that we are doing something about this *already*—maybe we just did not realize it. Deaf ministries (including evangelism) are one of the many ministries supported by our annual Margaret Lackey State Missions offering. This offering also supports Christian camps, church multiplication, disaster relief, criminal justice ministries, collegiate outreach (like our local BSU at MCC), Christian Women's/Men's Job Corps (which our church will begin hosting this fall), cross-cultural evangelism, and other ministries. We will be taking up this special offering throughout the month of September with a church goal of \$9,500 toward our state goal of \$2.1 million. Please prayerfully consider how you—and we can help minister to people we may never meet this side of Heaven. Everyone needs to "hear" the Gospel of Jesus Christ, including those who "hear" it differently than I/you/we did. Blessings, Nathan VanHorn
