I read an article not long ago that is worth considering. A study at Johns Hopkins University concluded that churchgoers live longer. A large sampling of the population indicates that the annual death rate for weekly churchgoers is about 500 per 100,000. The annual rate per 100,000 of occasional churchgoers jumps to 900. This means that the death rate for non-churchgoers is nearly double that of their neighbors who attend regularly.

The study naturally could not delineate the reasons for these statistics, but the results should not be surprising. Folks who take time for church have learned to manage their schedules. They live and function in a more relaxed fashion. While not being totally free from anxiety, certainly churchgoers have access to a faith that provides trust and some lessening of daily tensions. The benefits of scripture and music give hope and confidence and endless other sources of support and nurture.

Of course, the reason for attending church is not to live longer, but to live better. Some people live long, but poorly. There are those who realize that the good life has depth, height, and breadth, as well as length. Jesus said it best, "I came that they might have life..." Sounds like a good deal to me!
