DON'T LOSE HEART.

One of life's greatest risks is to lose heart;

to reach a point where we become cynical and discouraged. Often in his letters to young churches, Paul urged his people to keep their spirits up and not let the difficulties of the day cause them to lose their spirit.

How do you keep your heart? One way is to avoid piling up disasters so that they form a wailing wall. Centuries ago, Jeremy Taylor put this advice picturesquely: "How many people are busy gathering thorns to sit on?" They multiply the obstacles so that they lose heart before the heart really has a chance to get in to the battle. We need to keep our heart fortified. Paul asked: "If God is for us, who can be against us?" We keep heart by remembering that our labor is not in vain in the Lord.

In our world there are a variety of ways to lose heart, but a strong personal faith can give us the hopefulness and resilience needed to move forward through gloom and despair. Do not forget Paul's advice to the Corinthians:

"By God's mercy...we do not lose heart."
