

Freedom in Christ and the 4th of July!

July 4th is a gift. We didn't earn it—we received from the people who lived, led,



and died to fight for it. Everyone who gets a gift has two questions. First, "Who is it from?" Second, "What does it do?" My freedom in Christ is from Jesus. I didn't earn it. He died for it. That's who it's from, but what does it do? Galatians 5:1 reminds me, it's for freedom we've been set free. What does my freedom do? Give more freedom. It's freedom for me, my marriage, my kids, my friends, my co-workers, and my neighbors. I was given this gift to share.

It's a celebration of restoration complete with fireworks and great food... all to celebrate liberty once lost—but now found.
