Dear First Baptist Church,

Please let me say thank you to First Baptist
Church and the memory of Ellen Rogers

for these past five years teaching English there! When I returned from Honduras in 2017 to help Mom, Ellen invited me to help her with her class AND to move my other classes into her classroom. So generous. Five years later, both Mom and Ellen have gone ahead of us and, hopefully, COVID is behind us. In the meantime, working with Ellen and Lisa Powell, Jeanne Havard, Carolyn Tucker, Brittney Harkins, Dakota Cason and so many others who helped in this ministry, with books provided by the church, providing childcare with recreation, study and devotions, we were able to help more than 30 people improve their English, hear the gospel, and feel welcome in their chosen home. "Teacher, I took my son to a teacher's meeting at school. I understood everything." "Teacher, my husband asked if he needed to stay home from work to help me take my child to the doctor. I said, no. I can do it." "O Teacher, I used to aet \$250 a week to clean tables at the restaurant. Now I can take orders and get more than \$400 a week!"

Our students have been from Mexico, Guatemala, Honduras, Nicaragua, Costa Rica, Puerto Rico, Colombia, France, Spain, Italy, The Philippines and South Korea! On zoom, students have attended from Meridian, Miami, Colombia, Houston, Mexico, Honduras, and California.

We've seen six of our students pass their interview and get their U.S. citizenship! We've helped others continue their education or career. And we've provided a safe place for people to land when they are so far from their original homes. "I feel home here, now." "This room is where I feel at home."

Now I'll be moving on - back to Honduras to continue teaching there. I'll keep teaching the classes on Zoom. Please keep me in your prayers, and thank you so much.
