UNWORTHY

"When Jesus heard this He was amazed at him."

(Luke 7:9a)

Parenting is often a frustrating experience. Some of the lessons of life we try so hard to teach our children seem to go in one ear and out the other. Sometimes we wonder if they will ever develop the traits we desire for them. Then, there are those occasional moments, when we are least expecting it, when children will say or do something that indicates they really were listening after all. Who would have thought it?

Occasionally, Jesus, too, was pleasantly surprised to find someone in whom His message had unexpectedly taken root. The verse for today is a part of a larger story in which a Roman centurion, a person who was not among those to whom Jesus usually preached, demonstrated such a genuine faith that Jesus marveled at him. Jesus even said that He had not seen so great a faith among the people.

Many folks in Jesus' audience thought that faith was a matter of accomplishment. Those who carefully followed the Old Testament laws and performed good works believed that the Roman centurion who built their synagogue and treated them with respect also deserved Jesus' attention. The centurion sent word to Jesus saying, "I am not worthy." He could only ask for help based on Jesus' mercy. We need to be careful in assuming anything about ourselves. We become ready only when we claim "unworthy."
